#### Where can we get info throughout the year?

Our website, Facebook, monthly newsletter, and weekly texts will keep you constantly updated on what's going on in Aftershock student ministry. Check out www.corningfbc.com.

#### How should I pay for events? Do you take cash? Visa? MasterCard?

Checks and cash are fine. And, we do accept credit cards.

#### Who do I make the check-out to?

All checks should be made out to FBC Corning Youth with the event and student's name in the "memo" section. You may pay for more than one event at a time or even in advance for one or all upcoming events.

#### What should I do with my cash payments?

All cash should be sealed in an envelope with the amount, event, and student's name written on the front. Please do not bring money when dropping off your student for a trip! All payments should be brought or sent to the church office with attention Daniel on it prior to events.

Registrations can be done through our website for any event.

#### Why do you have non-refundable deposits?

Two reasons. 1) Most arrangements for overnight events require advanced deposits on our part. 2) It enables us to make concrete plans for transportation, meals, lodging, and programs. If you need to cancel a registration, please call Daniel ASAP!



#### What do we pack for trips?

Most overnight trips will require a sleeping bag and pillow. We will let you know if otherwise. Clothes should be packed in a suitcase or duffel bag. Each youth is allowed one suitcase and one backpack (unless notified otherwise). Each trip will have its own list of necessary items. Please label everything with your student's name.

## If my student brings a friend does he/she need a signed permission form and emergency medical form?

Yes. It is simply too big of a risk to take any youth offsite without written consent from their parents.

#### As a parent, what can I do to have a stronger relationship with my student?

The spiritual lives of teenagers are strongly influenced by the relationship they have with their parents. Dr. Robert Laurent, author of Keeping Your Teen In Touch With God, lists seven factors parents can work on to strengthen family bonds:

- 1. Renew your own passion for Christ.
- 2. Verbally express your love for your teen.
- 3. Learn to keep their confidence and take them seriously. 4. Be vulnerable and admit when you are wrong.
- 5. Never embarrass your teenager.
- 6. Forgive and forget.
- 7. Give your teenagers your time and attention.

## STUDENT MINISTRY POLICIES

#### Our Mission:

To make disciples of Jesus Christ by teaching biblical truths, investing in relationships and equipping students to serve Christ and others.

#### This is accomplished by:

"Reach up, Reach out, and Reach in". These three are the biblical mandates of the local church.

#### Reach Up

We work hard to provide an exciting and God-honoring environment for worship. When we worship God, we express our love and devotion to Him. All of us are wired for worship, and the only way we can express true love to God and worship Him is through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

#### **Reach Out**

Another key purpose is to reach out to people who are outside the family of God. Every day, we rub shoulders with people who are just an invite away from a life-changing encounter with Christ. Invite your friends, family, neighbors and co-workers to attend church so they will hear and understand what it means to be a follower of Christ.

#### Reach In

We also exist to help you as a Christ-follower grow in your spiritual maturity and become full-court followers of Christ. Because the Christian life is one of constant growth and development, we are focused on providing biblical principles that can be applied to everyday life. We want to help you move from a spectator in the stands to the game of active service.

#### **General policy**

#### **Chaperones and Supervision**

All chaperones on student ministry events must be at least 21 years of age and be a member of FBC. They are to follow all rules and regulations set by FBC. Chaperones are to set the example for the students. All chaperones and youth workers must meet the approval of the student pastor. No student is allowed in the youth room without adult supervision. This is for the safety of the student and the church.

#### **Dress Code**

Males and females should always wear modest clothing. Shorts are too short if you can touch skin when your arms and hands are straight down. No cheerleading shorts or shorts with writing on the back area. Shirts are too short if skin is shown when arms are raised. Ladies, please do not wear tight or revealing tops or bottoms. Men, please do not wear muscle shirts and keep your pants pulled up. All bathing suits should be one piece (bikinis only if accompanied by a dark colored t-shirt on top)

#### No Food or Drink

No food or drinks are allowed in the sanctuary of the church. This is so we take pride in what we have been given.

#### Discipline Policy General Rules (Ministry Events, Aftershock Meetings, and Sunday school Hour)

- 1. Do not use any foul or inappropriate language of any kind.
- 2. There will be no PDA (Public Display of Affection) of any kind on the church campus.
- 3. Dress appropriately. Do not wear clothing that is revealing or that has inappropriate words or phrases on them. You will be asked to change clothes!
  - 4. Always respect authority and each other.
  - 5. Be where you are supposed to be. Certain areas of the church are off limits (ex: empty classrooms, etc.) You must remain in the youth room area.
  - 6. No one is allowed in the fellowship hall during our worship service.

#### Discipline Procedure

1st Offense - Warning

2nd Offense - Parental contact

3rd Offense - Parent and student conference with student minister

4th Offense - Conference with head pastor

5th Offense - Revoke admission privileges

Violations relating to moral issues may invoke the 5th offense punishment.

#### **Damages/Incidents and Emergencies**

#### **Damages**

A damage report sheet must be filled out by the person in charge (youth minister or chaperone) for any damage done (accidental or otherwise) by the student or chaperone in the youth room. This report is to be turned in to the church office within 24 hours of the accident. The person responsible for the damage will be charged for the cost of any broken equipment.

#### **Incidents**

An incident report sheet must be filled out by the person in charge (youth minister or chaperone) for any incidents that occur at the youth room. This report is to be turned in to the church office within 24 hours of the incident. If the incident requires emergency medical attention please call 911 immediately. Contact a parent or guardian of the student ASAP. If the incident does not require emergency medical attention there are first aid kits located in the office of the youth building.

#### **Controlled Substance**

No alcohol, tobacco products, fireworks, firearms, or other weapons are allowed on FBC property. Drugs of any kind, unless prescribed by a physician, are not permissible.

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




